- The enrolment fee must be paid within ten days of receiving a positive reply from the admissions team.
- The advance payment of the Year 12 tuition will be deducted from the first term invoice (Year 12).
- Tuition is paid in three equal instalments before the start of each term.

Discounts and Scholarships

There is a 5% discount for all families with two or more children enrolled in Virtus College.

The Drive scholarship implies a 15% reduction of the tuition costs throughout the two years and is conceded to two students at the start of Year 12.

Entry Requirements

Our minimum entry requirements are:



At least 6 (I)GCSE's with a minimum grade of C (4) including, mandatorily, Maths and English Language.



A minimum grade of 6 (B) in the (I)GCSE subjects that the student wishes to study as A-Levels.



To study Mathematics and/or Science, students must have at least a grade 7 (A) in the equivalent (I)GCSE.



To study Further Mathematics, students must have at least a grade 8-9 (A*) in Mathematics (I)GCSE.
